The categories are as follows: Grades K-2<sup>nd</sup>; 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup>; 6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>; and 9th-12<sup>th</sup>

In order to be eligible for the recognition awards the student must:

- Be in grades K-12
- Bring his/her work (a maximum of two pieces per student) to the show between 10:00 and 11:00 a.m.
- Send or take to the Studio the entry form by the deadline on April 24.
- Attend the awards ceremony at 5:00 p.m.
- Artwork need not be framed or matted, but should have a rigid support (such as cardboard or foam board) and a hook, string or wire for hanging.
- Artwork must have an I.D card (provided by the guild) attached to the front with the students name and grade.
